The University Skating Club is proud to continue to offer adult skaters the opportunity to pursue excellence in ice dance and free skating.

Programs/Schedule

There are no skill level restrictions on USC sessions, but all of our sessions are intended for skaters 18 years of age and older as of the beginning of Sept. 2009.

Saturday Open Practice 12:00-1:30 pm

Freestyle and ice dancing can be practiced. Two levels of group lesson are offered during the first 15 minutes: a basic skating skills lesson and a stroking session for more advanced skaters.

Dates: Jan. 9 – Mar. 27, 2010 (12 sessions)

Sunday Open Practice 12:40-1:50 pm

Freestyle and ice dancing can be practiced. Two levels of group lesson are offered during the first 15 minutes: a basic skating skills lesson and a stroking session for more advanced skaters.

Fee: \$185 (tax included)
Dates: Jan. 10 – Mar. 28, 2010 (12 sessions)

Sunday Social Ice Dance 2:00-3:00 pm

This is a dance-only session. Programmed music including dances at all levels, from Preliminary to Diamond, will be played. No partner is required.

Fee: \$150 (tax included)
Dates: Jan. 10 – Mar. 28, 2010 (12 sessions)
Shortened sessions: 1:30 to 2:30pm on 3 sessions. See the "Social Sunday Ice Dance Calendar" for specific dates.
